## Program Samples for Wedding Ceremonies

The following samples can be used as a reference when building your unique program. We recommend finalizing your specific choices at least 1 month prior to the wedding day.

### Sample 1 – Traditional

**Prelude Music** – 10 Songs, or a total of 30 minutes.

Selections by Baroque and Classical composers, such as “Spring” by Vivaldi, “Rondeau” by Mouret, “Arioso” by Bach, and “Eine Kleine Nachtmusik” by Mozart. Creating a light and warm atmosphere is essential to welcoming your guests as they enter the venue.

#### The Ceremony

1. Entrance of the Mothers and Grandmothers – “Jesu, Joy of Man” by J.S. Bach
2. Entrance of the Bridesmaids – “Air” – by J.S. Bach
3. Procession of the Bride – “Bridal Chorus” – by R. Wagner
4. Interlude (Candle Lightening, Sand Ceremony, Prayer, etc.) – “Largo” by A. Vivaldi
5. Recessional of the Newlyweds – “The Wedding March” by F.B. Mendelssohn

#### Postlude

1. “The Rejoicing” – by G.F. Handel
2. “Hornpipe” – by H. Purcell

### Sample 2 – Contemporary / Mixed

**Prelude Music** - 10 Songs, or a total of 30 minutes.

Selections from Classical and Romantic composers, such as “Divertimento” by Mozart, “Flower Duet” by Delibes, “The Swan” by Saint-Saens, and “Clair de Lune” by Debussy.

#### The Ceremony

1. Entrance of the Mothers and Grandmothers – “All I Ask of You” from Phantom of the Opera
2. Entrance of the Bridesmaids – “Salut d’Amour” – by E. Elgar
3. Procession of the Bride – “Canon” – by Pachelbel, or “Gabriel’s Oboe” – by Ennio Morricone
4. Interlude (Candle Lightening, Sand Ceremony, Prayer, etc.) – “One Hand, One Heart” from West Side Story
5. Recessional of the Newlyweds – “Viva la Vida” - Coldplay

#### Postlude

1. “Signed, Sealed, Delivered” - by Stevie Wonder
2. “La Vie en Rose” – by E. Piaf

### Sample 3 – Modern

#### Prelude Music - 10 Songs, or a total of 30 minutes.

Selections from Contemporary composers and 20<sup>th</sup> Century film music, such as “Moon River” from Breakfast at Tiffany’s, “Over the Rainbow” from Wizard of Oz, The Beatles, Coldplay, and Show tunes standards.

#### The Ceremony

1. Entrance of the Mothers and Grandmothers – “Shallow” – by Lady Gaga
2. Entrance of the Bridesmaids – “Señorita” – by Shawn Mendes and Camila Cabello
3. Procession of the Bride – “Perfect” – Ed Sheeran
4. Interlude (Candle Lightening, Sand Ceremony, Prayer, etc.) – “Turning Page” - from Twilight: Breaking Dawn
5. Recessional of the Newlyweds – “Marry You” – by Bruno Mars

#### Postlude

1. “Happy” – by Pharrell Williams
2. “Don’t Stop Believin” - by Journey

### Sample 4 – Catholic Wedding

#### Prelude Music - 10 Songs, or a total of 30 minutes.

Selections by Baroque and Classical composers and Hymns. “O Perfect Love”, “Ave Maria”, “Sheep May Safely Graze”, “How Beautiful”, “Glory to God in the Highest”.

#### The Ceremony

1. Entrance of the Wedding Party – “Jesu, Joy of Man” by J.S. Bach
2. Procession of the Bride – “Canon” – by Pachelbel
3. Responsorial Psalm – “The Lord Is Kind and Merciful” – Hymnal
4. Gospel Acclamation – “Celtic Alleluia”
5. Presentation of the Gifts – “Prayer of St. Francis”
6. **Mass Parts:** Sanctus – “Holy, Holy”; Memorial Acclamation - “When We Eat This Bread”; Great Amen - “Amen”
7. Sign of Peace Interlude - “Largo” from Vivaldi’s 4 Season
8. Lamb of God - “Lamb of God”
9. Communion - “Lord’s Prayer” – by A. Malotte
10. Offering to the Blessed Mother – “Ave Maria” by F. Schubert
11. Recessional of the Newlyweds – “Joyful, Joyful We Adore Thee” – by L. van Beethoven

1. “The Rejoicing” – by G.F. Handel
2. “Hornpipe” - by G.F. Handel
